

Notice is hereby given that members of the Board of Directors of North Austin Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a special meeting on **Saturday, July 26, 2008, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the offices of Southwest Water Company, 9511 Ranch Road 620 North, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

1. Discuss and consider taking any necessary action regarding drainage proposal for the Community Building;
2. Discuss and consider taking any necessary action regarding landscaping proposal for the Community Building;
3. Receive status report and discuss and consider taking any other necessary action regarding pool and community center building operations, repairs and construction, including pay estimates, change orders, and approval of related proposals;
4. Discuss and consider approval of payment of any necessary bills and invoices;
5. Discuss and consider taking any necessary action regarding Interlocal Agreement with Williamson County regarding Rattan Creek Trail;
6. Discuss and consider taking any necessary action regarding MS4 permitting;
7. Conduct work session for draft budget and tax rate projections for the 2008-2009 fiscal year; and
8. Such other matters as may come before the Board.

The Board of Directors is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes. These purposes include receiving legal advice from its attorney (Texas Government Code, §551.071); discussing real property matters (§551.072); discussing gifts and donations (§551.073), discussing personnel matters (§551.074) or discussing security personnel or devices (§551.076). If the Board of Directors determines to go into executive session on any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Texas Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
